

**ORDINANCE No. 22/2022**  
**of the Rector of the University of Wrocław**  
**of 28 January 2022**

**modifying Ordinance No. 86/2019 of the Rector of the University of Wrocław of 11 June 2019 on the introduction of the Rules and Regulations on the provision of financial support for the students of the University of Wrocław**

Pursuant to Article 23, paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2021, item 478, as amended [Dz. U. z 2021, poz. 478, z późn. zm.]), it is ordered as follows:

§ 1. The following amendments are made to the Rules and Regulations on the provision of financial support for the students of the University of Wrocław, constituting an Appendix to the Ordinance No. 86/2019 of the Rector of the University of Wrocław of 11 June 2019 on the introduction of the Rules and Regulations on the provision of financial support for the students of the University of Wrocław:

**1)** in § 3, section 2, point 7 shall be deleted;

**2)** § 7 shall read as follows:

„§ 7

1. The benefits referred to in § 2, section 1 shall be available for first-cycle studies, second-cycle studies and uniform master's studies.
2. A student who simultaneously studies in several fields of study may receive benefits referred to in § 2, section 1 only in one field of study indicated by him/her.
3. The benefits referred to in § 2, section 1 shall not be granted to a student holding a professional degree: :
  - 1) a Master's degree, a Master of Engineering or equivalent;
  - 2) a Bachelor's degree, an Engineer's degree or equivalent if he/she resumes a first-cycle programme.
4. The total period for which the benefits referred to in § 2, section 1 are payable is 12 semesters, regardless of whether the student receives them or not, with the reservation that within this period the benefits are payable for studies:
  - 1)** First-degree – not longer than 9 semesters;
  - 2)** Second-degree – not longer than 7 semesters.
5. The total period in section 4 shall be longer by two semesters if a student has undertaken a full-time master's programme whose duration as defined by the law stands at 11 or 12 semesters.
6. The period referred to in sections 4 and 5 shall include all semesters of study as set out in section 1 started by the student, including semesters completed during the period of leave referred to in Article 85, section 1, subsection 3 of the Law on Higher Education and Science, except for semesters of a consecutive first-cycle programme started or continued after the obtaining of a first-cycle bachelor's degree, engineer's degree or an equivalent degree. In the case of education in several fields of study, semesters that are taken simultaneously shall be treated as one semester.
7. If the disability arose in the course of studies or after obtaining a professional degree, the benefit referred to in § 2, section 1, point 2,

shall be granted for an additional period of 12 semesters. The provisions of sections 4 and 6 shall apply respectively.

8. The provisions of paragraphs 1 to 7 shall apply respectively to students who studied or obtained their degrees abroad.”;

**3)** § 8 shall read as follows:

„§ 8

1. The decision to grant the student benefit referred to in § 2, section 1 shall expire on the last day of the month in which the student:
  - 1) has lost the right to benefit due to obtaining a professional degree referred to in § 7, sections 3 and 8;
  - 2) was expelled from the list of students in the course in which he/she was receiving benefits;
  - 3) the period referred to in § 7 sections 4, 5 and 7 has expired.
2. A student applying for or receiving a benefit referred to in § 2, section 1 shall immediately notify the University of the occurrence of a circumstance resulting in the loss of entitlement to the benefit pursuant to § 7, sections 3-8.
3. Benefits collected on the basis of false data or a false declaration by the student shall be returned under pain of disciplinary liability.”.

§ 2. The supervision of the implementation of this regulation is entrusted to the Vice-Rector for student affairs.

§ 3. The Ordinance shall enter into force on the day of its signature, with effect from 1 March 2022.
