In the implementation of planned activities for the promotion of the Faculty of Biotechnology, I announce a competition for development of a graphic design to be printed on T-shirts/t-shirts or other promotional materials of the Faculty of Biotechnology of the University of Wrocław.

1. The aim of the competition is to select the best graphic design that will identify the Faculty of Biotechnology at the University of Wrocław and promote its scientific and teaching activities.
2. The competition is open to students, doctoral students and employees of the Faculty of Biotechnology at the University of Wrocław.
3. The project guidelines, application and competition rules are contained in the Competition Rules annexed to this Communication.

5. **Applications can be submitted until 28 February 2026** and the results will be announced no later than 13 March 2026.

# **Rules of the competition for the design of graphics promoting Faculty of Biotechnology of the University of Wrocław**

## **§ 1. Competition organiser**

1. The organiser of the competition is the Faculty of Biotechnology of the University of Wrocław, based in Wrocław (hereinafter: "Organiser").
2. The organiser announces a competition for the author's design of graphics to be printed on T-shirts/blues or other promotional materials of the Faculty of Biotechnology of the University of Wrocław.

## **§ 2. Competition objective**

6. The aim of the competition is to select the best graphic design that will identify the Faculty of Biotechnology at the University of Wrocław and promote its scientific and teaching activities.
7. The project should relate to biotechnology, biological sciences or the academic identity of the Faculty of Biotechnology at the University of Wrocław.

## **§ 3. Participants in the competition**

1. The competition is open to students, doctoral students and employees of the Faculty of Biotechnology at the University of Wrocław.
2. Participation in the competition is free of charge.
3. Participants can take part individually or in teams (maximum 2 people).
4. Each participant or team can submit a maximum of two projects.
5. Designs must be original, original and must not infringe on the rights of third parties.
6. The competition is not open to members of the jury or their family members.

## **§ 4. Subject of the competition**

1. The subject of the competition is the development of a graphic design to be printed on T-shirts/blues or other promotional materials of the Faculty of Biotechnology of the University of Wrocław.
2. The project must not contain content that is offensive, discriminatory, political, religious or contrary to good morals and must not harm the good name of the Faculty of Biotechnology and the University of Wrocław.
3. In accordance with the guidelines contained in the Standards for the Use of Elements of the Visual Identification System of the University of Wrocław, published in the UWr Rector's Ordinance No. 43/2025, the submitted project cannot include the emblem or logo of the University of Wrocław.
4. The design must be prepared in a printable colour version.
5. The design should be submitted in a vector format allowing for scaling without loss of quality (e.g. SVG, EPS) and in a preview format (e.g. PDF, PNG or JPG), enabling the design to be assessed by the Competition Jury.
6. Applications must be accompanied by 1 to 3 visualisations of the design on the T-shirt.

## **§ 5. Applications and timetable**

1. Designs should be sent electronically to the e-mail address indicated by the Organiser in the competition announcement.
2. The deadline for the submission of projects and the date of the announcement of the results will be announced in the competition notice.
3. The application should include:
  - a. project files,
  - b. visualisations,
  - c. application form (**Appendix 1**) and GDPR statement (**Appendix 2**).
4. The eligibility of a project for the competition is determined by the fulfilment of the formal requirements.

## **§ 6. Project evaluation and awards**

1. The evaluation of the submitted projects is carried out by the Competition Commission appointed by the Organiser.
2. The Commission evaluates the projects in terms of creativity, compatibility with the subject matter of the competition and practical applicability.
3. There is no right of appeal against the decisions of the Competition Commission.
4. The organiser envisages that prizes will be awarded in the form of subsidised costs related to participation in the training/conference/workshop trips:

**First prize - up to PLN 5,000**

**Second prize - up to PLN 3,000**

**Third prize - up to PLN 2,000**

The funds must be used by the end of 2026.

## **§ 7. Copyright**

1. By submitting a project, the participant declares that he/she has full copyright and property rights in the submitted project.
2. The participant is liable for any third-party claims arising from copyright infringement.
3. By entering the Competition, the Participant grants the Organiser permission to make the submitted Project public and to publish the Participant's full name on the Organiser's website, as well as on social media and in the Organiser's own promotional materials.
4. By entering the Competition, the Participant declares that, in the event of winning the Competition, they will enter into an agreement transferring the economic copyright in the Project to the Organiser, in accordance with the agreement set out in **Appendix No. 3** to the Rules. The award will be paid upon delivery of the signed agreement.

## **§8. Final provisions**

1. The organiser reserves the right to adapt the submitted projects to the guidelines contained in the Rector's Ordinance No. 43/2025 on the Visual Identification System of the University of Wrocław.

2. The organiser reserves the right not to award prizes if none of the projects meet the evaluation criteria.
3. Any questions regarding the competition should be directed to the email address indicated by the Organiser in the competition announcement.

**I. General provisions**

§ 1

- 1) The author declares that he/she created the author's work for the purpose of the competition for the design of a graphic promoting the Faculty of Biotechnology of the University of Wrocław / to be printed on T-shirts/blouses.
- 2) The piece was delivered before the agreement was signed and awarded I/II/III.

§ 2

- 1) The author declares that the Work was created by him personally in 100% and that the Work does not infringe any rights or personal rights of third parties that could render the publisher liable.
- 2) The author declares that he is entitled to copyright in the Work and that these rights are not restricted in the scope of this agreement.
- 3) In the event that claims are made against the University by third parties for infringement of their rights or goods in connection with the publication or distribution of the Work, the Author agrees to enter into the pending proceedings as soon as he has been notified and to indemnify the University against all costs and charges in connection therewith.

**II. Rights granted**

§ 3

1. The Author hereby assigns to the University all copyrights held by the Author in the Work, in all fields of exploitation known at the date of execution of this Agreement, including in particular the right to:
  - a) produce and reproduce the Work, in whole or in part, by any technique, including printing, digital and computer recording, magnetic, electronic and other storage media (including computer drives and CD/DVDs), on paper, advertising materials, promotional items and gadgets;
  - b) place on the market, distribute and otherwise commercialise copies of the Work on which it has been fixed;

- c) disseminate the Work in any manner other than specified in point (b), including by reproduction, display and making the Work, in whole or in part, available free of charge or for consideration in such a way that members of the public may access it at a place and time individually chosen by them, including via the Internet, intranet and other teleinformation networks, as well as within multimedia digital databases, and in printed or electronic informational, promotional and advertising materials;
  - d) lend, display, hire and otherwise make available copies of the Work;
  - e) enter the Work into computer memory and other digital systems.
2. The rights referred to above apply both to the Work as a whole and to any individual parts thereof.
3. The Author authorises the University to make modifications to the Work, including alterations, adaptations, transformations and other derivative changes.
4. The Author agrees that the Work may be combined or juxtaposed with other works.
5. The Author assigns to the Publisher the exclusive right to exercise dependent (subsidiary) copyrights, including the unrestricted right to dispose of and use such rights.
6. The assignment of rights under this Agreement shall be unlimited and free from any territorial, temporal or other restrictions.
7. The transfer of copyrights under this Agreement shall take effect upon acceptance of the Work.
8. Together with the assigned copyrights, the Publisher shall acquire ownership of the physical media on which the Work is fixed.

### **III. Author's remuneration**

#### **§ 4**

The prize awarded as part of the competition shall simultaneously constitute the remuneration for all the titles indicated in this Agreement.

### **VII. Final provisions**

#### **§ 5**

1. All changes and additions to the Agreement must be in writing under pain of nullity.
2. The parties declare their mutual cooperation in the performance of this Agreement; any doubts and disputes will be resolved initially by direct negotiation, and only if an agreement cannot be reached by this means shall the court with jurisdiction over the Publisher's registered office be designated as the competent court to resolve the dispute.
3. The Agreement is drawn up in two counterparts, one for each Party or in electronic form.
